- BE AT LEAST 18 YEARS OLD in the calendar year of school/program admission.
 - PRINT or TYPE ANSWERS to ALL of the QUESTIONS listed below on a SEPARATE SHEET of PAPER as COMPLETELY and HONESTLY as possible.
 - SEND the completed application to the address listed above; all paperwork ***MUST BE POSTMARKED BY NO LATER THAN APRIL 30th***.
1. Please give your full legal name, your birthdate (month/day/year), your residential address (& mailing address if different from where you live), and your phone number(s).
 2. Are you an American citizen?
 3. In what way do you support the African American Heritage Foundation of Maui?
 4. What is your academic or vocational goal?
 5. Why are you interested in pursuing this goal?
 6. What activities have you already done to support your interest in obtaining this goal?
 7. Once you obtain your academic or vocational goal, how do you plan on using your gifts/skills/talents to impact your community?
(Your answer should be written in the form of a 500-word essay)
 8. What school or training program are you planning to attend?
(Give the name, address, and telephone number of the school or program with a contact person's name from there who can provide us with instructions on mailing a check on your behalf if you are awarded The Village Grant)
 9. Have you been accepted to this school/training program? If so, give your admission date.
 10. What institution offers accreditation to the school or training program you want to attend?
